On March 8, 2023 at 7:00 p.m., polls closed on the SGA Spring Election after two (2) days of voting. The year there was 799 total votes including in-person and absentee ballots. Election results were certified by the Judicial Court immediately following the election. The Student Government Association consists of an elected president, vice president, 26 college senators, and 12 senators at-large. This event will also recognize other student leaders and celebrate the work that the 2022-2023 SGA has completed while holding office.
